(Jesus speaking:)

I alone change not. If you can't see your way out and it seems to be all foggy, it's time to "feel after Me". You can't see Me, then feel your way.

ACT.17:27 That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us:

ACT.17:28 For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

MAR.3:10 For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.

MAR.6:56 And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched him were made whole.

MAR.8:22 And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

MAR.10:13 And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: and his disciples rebuked those that brought them....**MAR.10:16** And he took them up in his arms, put his hands upon them, and blessed them.

LUK.6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.

MAT.28:9 And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and worshipped him.

JOH.20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

JOH.20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My LORD and my God.

(touch the clean things) ISA.52:11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.

2CO.6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

Touch Jesus body? How can we feel and touch Him? By touching believers.

EPH.5:30 For **we are** members of his body, of his **flesh, and of his bones**.

LUK.24:39 Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not **flesh and bones**, as ye see me have.

JOH.2:21 But he spake of the **temple of his body**.

1CO.3:16 Know ye not that **ye are the temple of God**, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

(Jesus speaking:)

Have I not said that you are each My presence on Earth now in these days; and as you love one another you are indeed loving Me? For as you touch with kindness and loving affection, so do I feel it. Do I only feel when “the apple of my eyes” is touched by those harming those trusting in Me? Or do I likewise feel it when the touches of love given to sustain the bodies of believers are felt?
