(This messages is selected from a message on changing something permanently on my face—as someone offered it as a gift to me, to pay for it. But then came a message of some wild insight in to the rewards for those who yield all to Jesus and be what He made them to be here and now.)

And with each appearance option you'll learn new things, see things from new ways, and get to socialize with different people all over the planetary system; all kinds of creatures that exist.

I had to make the eyes to see this and not that, because what a human sees affects their actions and what they are accountable to take action on. Bugs and beasts aren't this way. And I won't hold them accountable for not doing something about a situation or condition that they see.

But with humans, what they see they judge; and what they determine is to them bad or wrong, I do require them to do something to change things for the better. At least some of the time. They have seen the cause and effect of this and that, right before their eyes.
