Like Moses who kept asking repeatedly if I would reconsider and change My plan, allowing him to cross to the promise land with the team. Eventually I had to say, "Stop asking; accept My final decision." And it really was for his good, and best that way.

I do have a best, but sometimes I'll let you do a "veer off" for a bit. But you'll know it's fine when I give you the green light to do it. But then, keep checking with Me and I'll blow the whistle and turn you around to keep making headway, more determined than ever, on the path I have laid for you.
