

## Dec 2020\_ Seek for Secrets

(Armina speaking: ) If you want to hear really cool things, then you need to listen with your heart. For that is how you'll get the understanding and ability to find out secrets that are hidden from others. You'll need to listen with your heart, not only with your ears. What I mean by that is you'll need to look at things in a new, spiritual way.

Here's an example of listening with your heart:

When Jesus told His disciples about the parable of the sower who sowed the seeds, some here and there, with various results of growth and success and fruit born, it was more than a story about farming, right? Yet, those who just wanted a story just heard that much and didn't understand more than that. But the wise guys knew Jesus had a secret He was hiding, covered from the world's eyes, but it would be plain to those who looked past the mere words and ideas to listen with their heart. Those who wanted to understand and to know what God was actually saying, got to find out something that would change their life for the better and benefit them for the rest of their life.

So, that's what I'm talking about.

Listen, yes, but do more: Hear, find out secrets from what is being said. Not everything will be said in plain English [or whatever language you speak], like as simple as one plus one is two. But for the smart and wise listeners, they will know that every word is important and leads like a clue to unlock a mystery, something that will benefit them too, for the rest of their life and on to the great new world of the spirit they will enter one day.

If you want to know more from what you read, just ask Jesus to give you the insight and the knowledge to see beyond what the text is saying. Ask Jesus to "unwrap" the gift of something wise told you from Heaven, and He will. He loves to hear you asking for understanding, like James says, "ask of God" for the wisdom to understand new and hidden things. (James 1:5)

And what is the benefit of finding out more than others, from God's written words?

"Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free."

So, why? Freedom is one reason. Freedom from the weights and cares of this life that bind you in a pickle—that is, a tricky situation to get free from. Freedom to do your Lord's will and get heavily rewarded for it.

It's the same reason you want to unlock a code that leads you to where a treasure is hidden for you to find.

Seek and ye shall find. Seek what? Seek the Lord—that is to say, have a face to face chat with Him. See Him with your spirit's eyes and mind and ask for the clue, the secrets. Seek and secrets go together; as do "security" and other "sec" and "see" types of words that you discover are appropriate.

Open your channel to hear from us today. There is lots that we want to tell you. And when you let us speak God's Words into your mind, then pause to hear more than just what the words are saying; get a deeper meaning and understanding and you'll learn things that many, many others have missed discovering.

It's like driving passed a neat play park and fun playground, or stopping to turn down that little road and enjoying it. When you read God's Word it's best not to zoom and zip past, as fast as you can, just skimming the surface of the text. For when He speaks it's always telling secrets somewhere in the text besides what it's saying plainly. But you have to let your heart "digest" what you read, and let God's Spirit show you things beyond what it seems to be simply saying. There are so many things veiled, or slightly covered up. But if you want to know the hidden secrets, and the time is right, you'll find them out, as Jesus will show these secrets to the hungry hearts, who are hungry for His hidden and special truths.
