50. Rewards

These words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt do that which is right and good in the sight of the Lord: that it may be well with thee. (Deuteronomy 6:6-7,18a, KJV)

Love

Love is the most important gift you can give. Love comes back to you. Jesus gives special rewards to those who show love to others. Love makes your life better and happier. Being loving shows others what God is like.

Joy

You can have joy in your heart no matter what happens, because Jesus will always love you and take care of you. If you first do what makes Jesus happy, then help to cheer up others, and put yourself last, you'll find that you feel happy too.

Peace

Jesus can give you peace in your heart. He can make the storms, troubles, stress, tension, and confusion not upset you. You can feel His peace when you pray, trust in Him, and remember the promises in His Word.

Patience

When you are patient, you know things will work out well. If you do something else while you wait for things to work out, waiting will be easier for you. If someone is testing your patience and is upsetting you, or if something is difficult for you, Jesus can help you to be calm and to make the right choices. Reading His Word can give you the faith you need to wait patiently until things are right again, or until things work out as you are hoping.

Gentleness

Talking softly and acting gently can inspire others to do the right thing too. Getting all worried, angry, loud, or acting rough with others won't make good things happen. When you relax and act kindly, and treat others gently, it will bring better results.

Goodness

There is always something good to think about and notice and do in each situation. Focus on what is right, and choose to do what is good. Things will be better for you when you talk about good things and make the right choices that please Jesus.

Faith

God's Word gives you faith and confidence to obey Him. Jesus loves you and when you pray and trust Him to take care of you it makes Him so happy. He will then do wonderful things for you. Jesus can help you to not worry about anything, but to know that He can always help you.

Faith

What can faith in God do for you? It can do a whole lot! It healed blind Bartimaeus' eyes. Jesus said to Bartimaeus, "Your faith has made you whole". Faith is just believing that God is, and that He is there with you, that He cares about you and that He loves you. Putting your faith in God is like putting your little hand in Daddy's big hand when you're walking along. You trust that he will lead you to good places and take care of you. It's just that simple, and it works just as well.

Meekness

Jesus likes to use little things and little people who don't have big ideas of their own but who let His Spirit lead them to do what He wants them to. They don't get worked up or upset when things don't go their way. Instead, they are trusting all the time that Jesus will work things out for them. And because they do, things usually turn out all right.

Moderation

It makes Jesus very happy when we're moderate and control our impulses. Just because we feel like doing something, or want to have a lot of something, doesn't mean we'll be happier if we get it. Being moderate helps us to take better care of ourselves by not overdoing—just having enough. We will be able to show more consideration for others when we aren't only focused on getting more for ourselves, which causes us to neglect the needs of others.

Word of God

God's Word is like a treasure chest full of jewels and gold. God put so many promises in His Word about His love and care for us, and each verse or promise is like something very beautiful and valuable. In fact, He even inspired the men who wrote the Bible so they would write down exactly what He wanted said! He did that because He loves you and doesn't ever want you to feel alone or lost in this world. The more you read God's Word, the more you will know just how much He loves you.

Holy Spirit

If you pray, God can send His comforting, miracle-working, powerful Holy Spirit to be with you and surround you. God's Holy Spirit, which He promised to send to those that believe in Jesus, can help us know what to say and do so we can tell people about Jesus. With God's Spirit helping us we won't feel so shy or sad. We'll instead be bubbling over with joy and power to do what Jesus wants us to do. God's Holy Spirit can teach us how to be more loving and kind with people. If we need help remembering things or learning something new, the Holy Spirit can help with that too. Isn't it nice to have an invisible Friend like that?

Prayer

Prayer is talking to Jesus and letting Him know what you need and what's on your heart. And just like having a conversation with a friend, prayer goes two ways. Jesus also likes to talk to you! So take a little time each day to tell Him what's on your heart and then get real quiet and let Him talk to you. He can give you all that you need in that little moment you spend with Him. It might be a comforting thought and peaceful feeling, or a reminder of His great love for you.

Hearing from Heaven

Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice." If we'll just be like little sheep and follow our Shepherd, Jesus, we'll hear His voice, too! Just get ready to listen, and you will hear Him. Or like your mummy asks you sometimes, "Are you listening?" That's what happened with young Samuel in the Bible: he took time to be quiet and to listen to what the Lord wanted to say to him. When you feel that Jesus wants to talk to you, you can say, like Samuel did, "Speak, Lord, I'm listening".

Golden Rule

Jesus said something once that is so important that we call it the Golden Rule. This is what He said: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you". When you feel bugged about something somebody did or said, that's a good time to practice the Golden Rule. Do your best to love that person anyway. Who knows? Maybe next time you'll be the one who needs the love and forgiveness of others!

Bible

The Bible is the most wonderful book in the whole world! In fact, it's more than just a book. It's like a special spiritual lamp that will instantly light up your path through life, and help you know what you are to do. It's also like a roadmap that will show you the best way to get to your destination, which is Heaven. The Bible is God's Letter written personally to you! Cherish God's words in the Bible and they will keep you close to Jesus, loving Him, and loving others.

Salvation

Jesus came to Earth to bring us God's wonderful gift of Salvation. God had so much love for each of us that He sent His son down from Heaven to live on Earth so we could know what God is like. After doing that, Jesus also gave His life for us, to take our punishment and forgive us our sins, so we could have the gift of salvation and eternal life in Heaven with Him and His Father. Choices to eat good food will affect how healthy you are.

Making Decisions

Making wise decisions takes thought and prayer, and knowing God's Word too. If we only rush to do what comes to our mind we will probably end up regretting a lot of the things we do. Deciding to do things that are faith- and life-building will make us much happier. Sometimes it's hard to do what we know is the right thing, but Jesus can help us choose to do what is best anyway, even if it seems difficult at first. If you stop to ask Jesus before you make a decision, you can be sure that your decision will be a good one.

Christmas

Thankfulness

Togetherness

If you and others are all in agreement as to what you are doing and how you want to go about something, this makes the project or game or activity go well. But if someone is trying to make themselves appear better than others, or they aren't appreciating the good qualities that the others have, then it causes disunity and disruption.

Choose good friends and teammates to play with and do things together with, people who also believe as you do. It's good to work with those who want to follow Jesus too. Then when you talk about plans or there are differences of opinion you can pray together, and each one can choose to do the most loving thing, speaking humbly and respectfully to each other. You'll have a great time then.

Yieldedness

We don't always get to have just what we want, at just the time we want it. Sometimes we have to wait or let others have a turn to get what they need. Sometimes we have to give up things that are special to us, or we get sick, or we miss out on something that we'd like. But if we pray every day for Jesus to help us make the right choices, and we have faith that He is in charge and will bring about the best things in our lives, then it won't seem as hard.

If we most of all want to do whatever Jesus knows is best, He works things out for us, helps us avoid accidents, and gives us more joy and peace in our heart. Jesus blesses those who remember to thank Him for all He did to make it possible for them to do well. We can also show humility by telling others what a great job they did, and saying words of appreciation to them. When we don't think of ourselves as deserving of all the best, and we let others feel special and respected, that shows humility; it's being like Jesus.

Angels

Jesus sends angels to help each person on Earth. If we pray for help and protection, His angels are ready and eager to help. When we make the choices to do things that please Jesus and we obey what He tells us, then His angels can care for us better. Jesus blesses us with His Heavenly protection as we pray and obey and stay close to Him. We are never alone on Earth. Jesus and His angels are always with us.

Healing

Everyone gets sick or hurt and needs healing sometimes. When Jesus came to Earth and gave His life, it was for the forgiveness of our sins and for the healing of our bodies too. He promises healing and relief to those who ask Him for it. There are many promises in God's Word that we can read and claim when we are sick or in pain. When you pray and remind Jesus of what He has promised, it shows Him that you have faith in His Word, and that you know He will heal you. When healing comes it will be like a touch of relief from Heaven. Healing is a special blessing from Jesus.

Giving

Putting others' needs first, and sharing what you can to make them happy, also puts a smile on Jesus' face. Like when you see the largest piece of snack on the plate and you manage to not grab it but offer the plate to the visitor instead. It makes Jesus happy when we think of others like that. That's how He lived His whole life on Earth! He was always thinking of others and putting their needs first.

Jesus has lots of surprises and gifts for those who make the right choice to be kind, helpful, and giving. You will be so glad for every deed, every prayer, every bit of love shared, every time you obeyed Jesus even when it was hard, every time you helped someone come to know Jesus. He'll give you so much in return. He then has special ways of thanking you and giving to you. No matter how much you give away to others, Jesus has much more that He can give back to you.

Faithfulness

Jesus told us in the Bible to be "faithful" and that He would bless this. He said that those who do their jobs for Him well and consistently, who would not give up, and who would put their time, strength, and energy into doing it well and right, He would say to them, "Well done!" when they meet Him in Heaven. I want to be someone who doesn't give up and who Jesus can richly reward one day, because I've made Him so happy by doing what He was depending on me to do. Don't you?

Obedience

Everything you do that makes Him happy and is in obedience to His Word, that helps to make this world a better place, or helps others to know about Jesus, will be rewarded. You will get very special treats in Heaven, and some on Earth too!—Because that makes Him very happy. When you get to Heaven you will see all the wonderful things that Jesus saved up for you.

Truth

If people can trust that what we say is the truth, then they can also believe us when we tell them about Jesus, and the way to Heaven. There is no room for lies and false ideas in the mouths of those who love and follow Jesus. We need to show a good example to others of being trustworthy and speaking things that are true and good, honesty and right.
