


102.) New Life and Living Water




104.) Fever Cured Immediately






When people heard that Jesus was at Peter's house, they came to the door to be healed by Him. He helped them and healed them all.



105.) Four Men and a New Idea


There was a man who couldn't walk or get around on his own. His friends heard that Jesus was speaking in a certain house nearby. Four of them carried this sick man to the house.






106.) Helping and Healing






107.) Mountain Meetings

Jesus said to be kind and to treat others with God's love, and then we'll be blessed and rewarded. He said to forgive others, and that God would forgive us.




Jesus said that those who love and know Him, and are trying to show and tell others what He is like, are as shining lights in the world.

The disciples were amazed that Jesus could do this miracle. He could even tell the weather what to do, and stop storms. They knew that Jesus, God's Son, could do anything.


Jesus is always with us and nothing is too stormy or too difficult for Him to take care of.

He knew that Jesus could help, and quickly went to find Him. He pleaded for Jesus to come and heal his daughter.


