


113.) Good Ground

Some seeds fell on rocky ground, and they didn't grow well because there wasn't deep soil for their roots.




Some seeds fell among the thorns and weeds, and couldn't grow up and bear fruit there.


Everyone was surprised and very happy!

When Peter was being asked for money by some temple tax collectors, he didn't know what to do. The tax collectors also wondered if Jesus was going to pay His tax.


Peter spent all his time helping others and travelling with Jesus as His disciple, and didn't have any coins to give them on that day.


Zacchaeus learned from Jesus that being kind and giving would make him feel happier.




117.) Rich Young Ruler




118.) Love and Forgiveness

When Jesus walked past him, He wanted to heal him. Jesus told him to wash his eyes in the pool of Siloam.




This man had been blind his whole life, but when he obeyed, he was suddenly able to see! When he talked with Jesus later, he believed that Jesus was God's Son.



Jesus told a story to show how much God loves us. The story was about a young man who wanted to go off and live a selfish life.


He didn't help his father and brother on the farm. He spent all his money on foolish things.

Jesus was walking a short distance away, and these men called out loudly for Jesus to heal them. Jesus told them to walk to the priest by faith and tell him that they were healed.




These men obeyed Jesus' instructions right away. They started walking to announce that they were healed, and as soon as they started obeying what Jesus said, they were healed!
