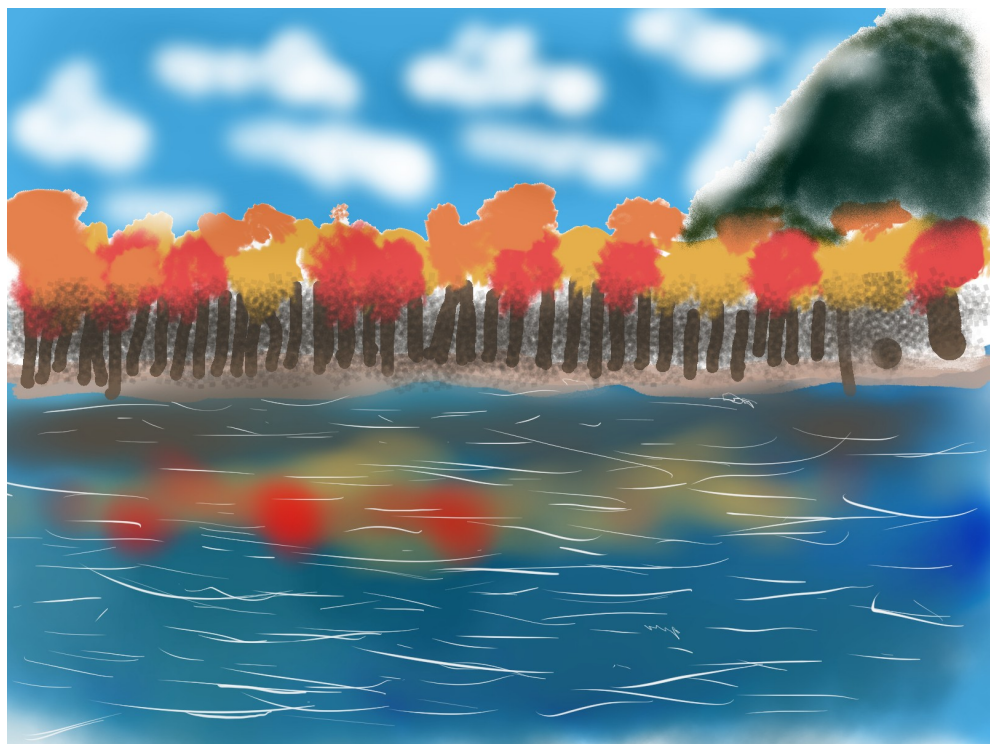

At night when you're in bed.

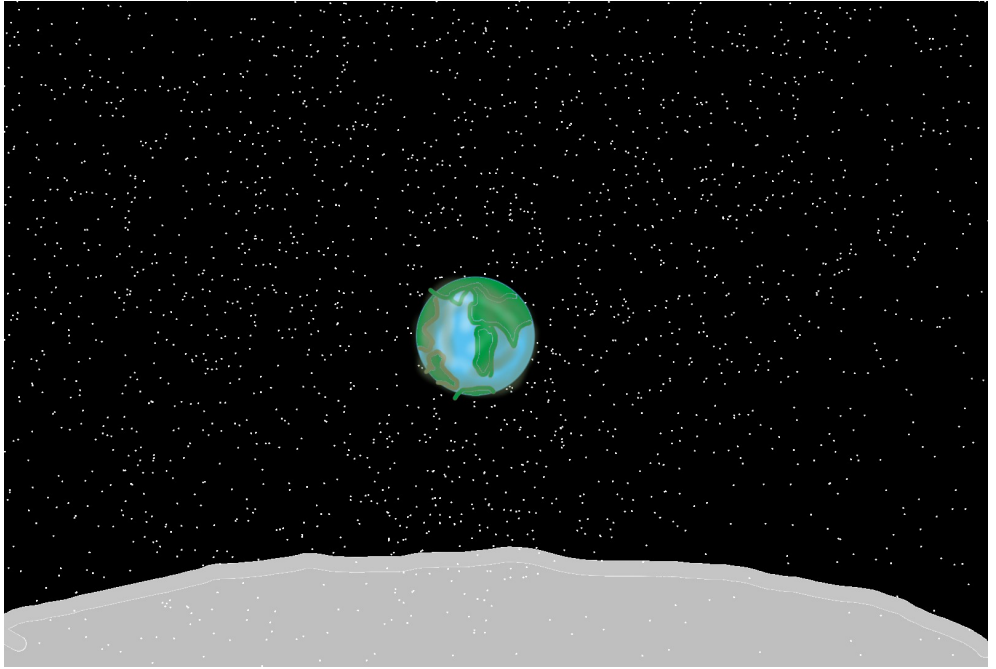

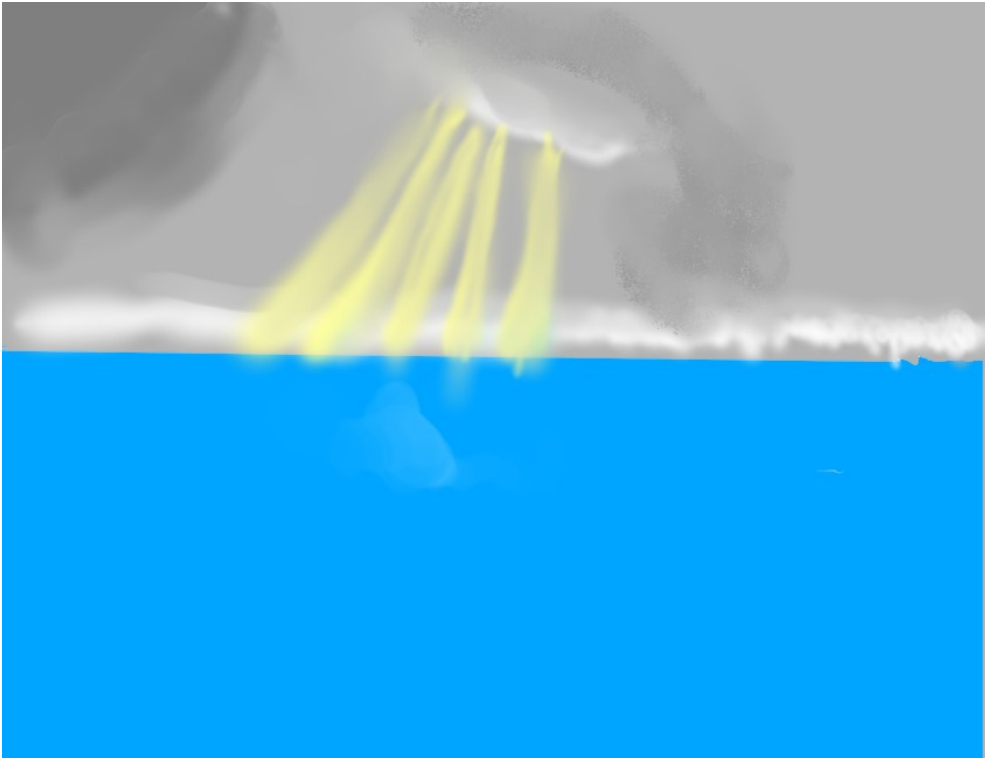
