

Jesus led them in a special ceremony. He passed around some bread and wine for the disciples to each take a little bite and sip of.




After the meal Jesus took a bowl of water and a towel, and washed each of the disciples' feet—just like a servant would do.

Jesus is God's gift of love to the world—to each person in it.


When people choose to do wrong, it separates them from God, and makes God sad.
