Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy.




Exodus 14:14 The Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.


Revelation 2:17b

Psalms 30:2 O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.


2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.




