counted it to him for righteousness.

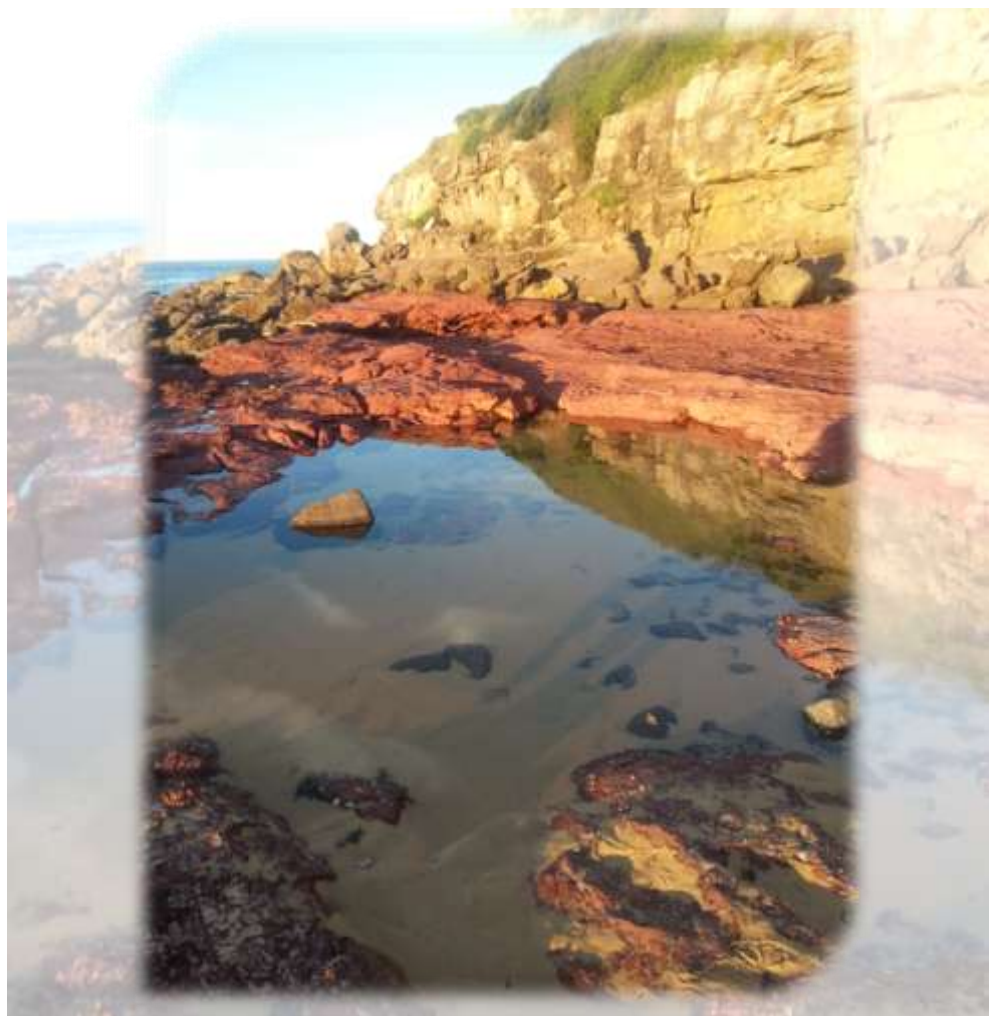

The just shall live by faith.

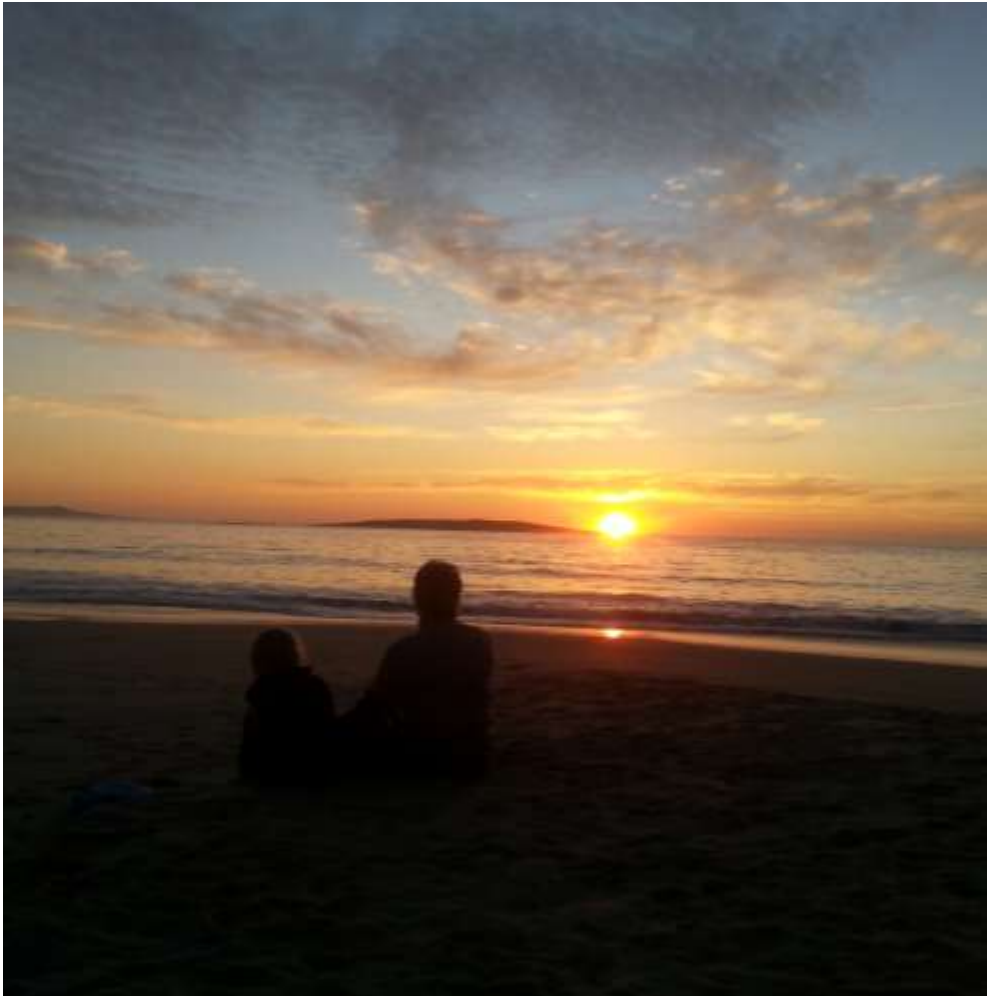

refuge in the day of my trouble.

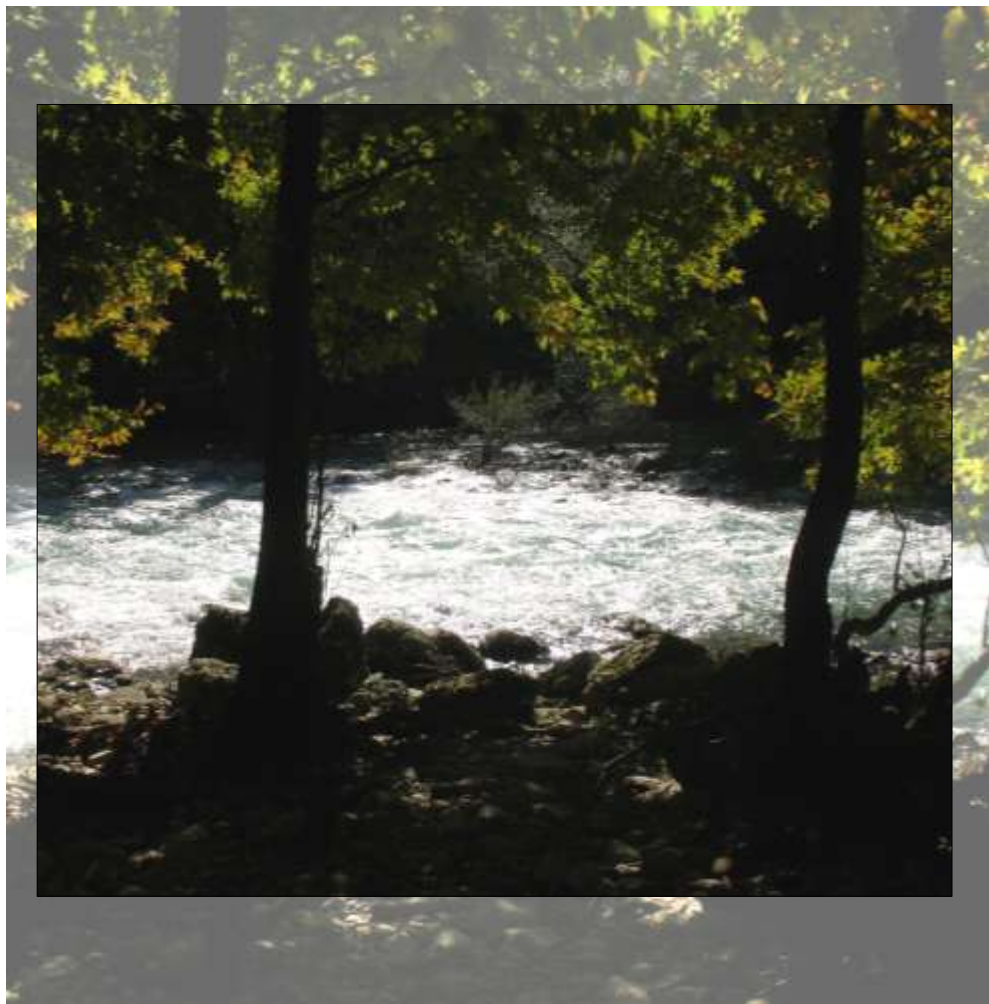
