judgments endureth for ever.

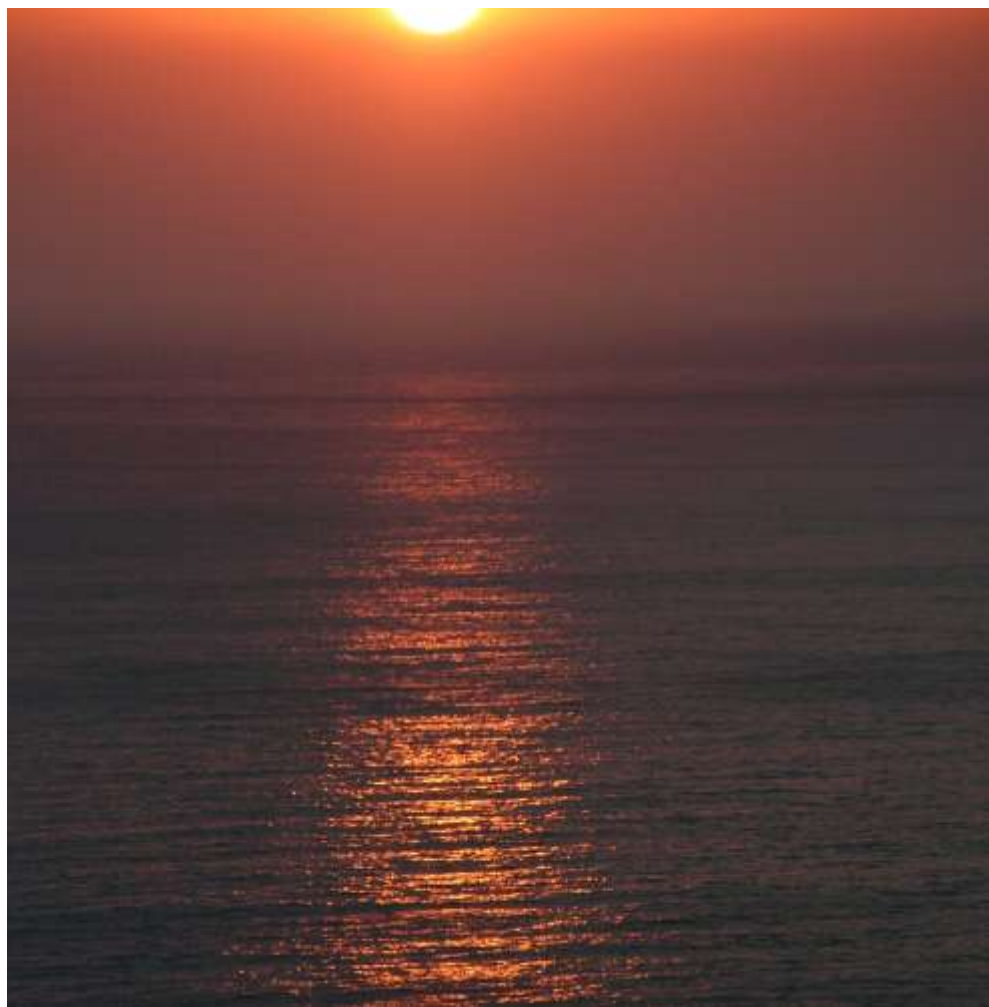
