good: for his mercy endureth for ever.



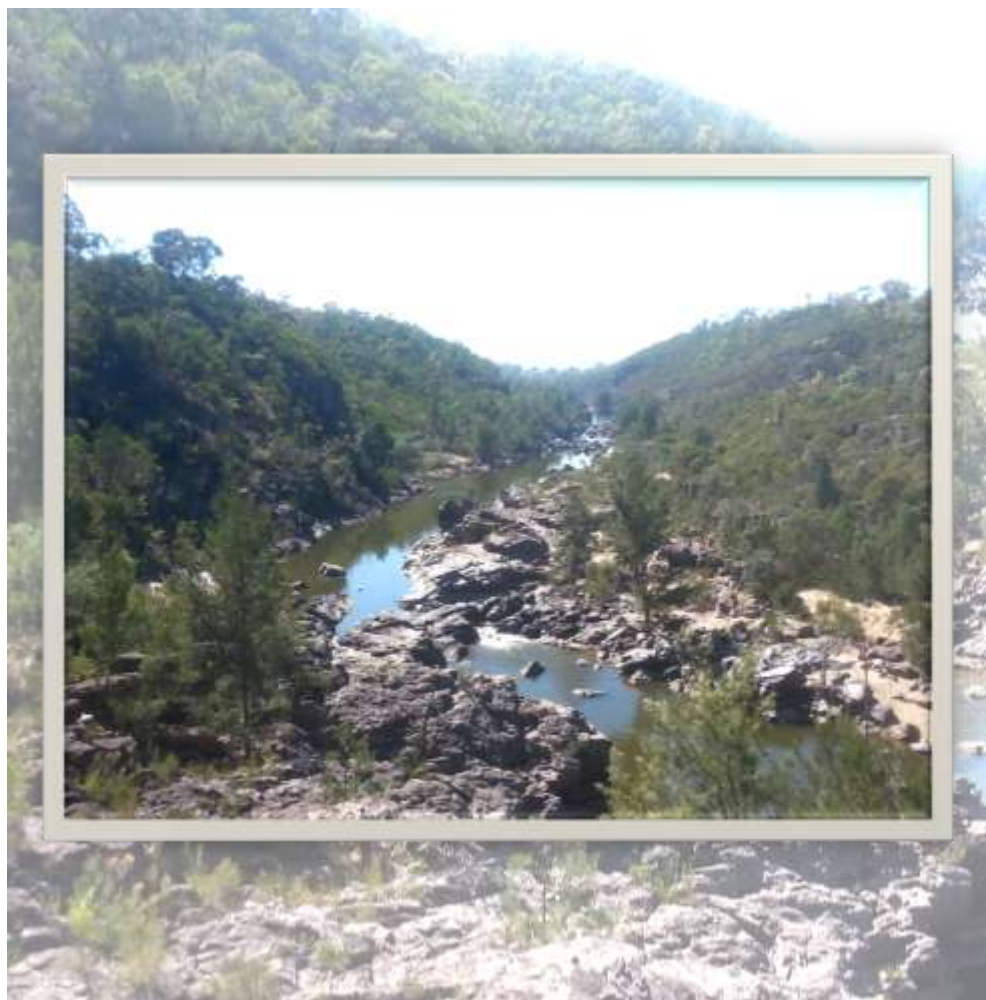

water shall he guide them.



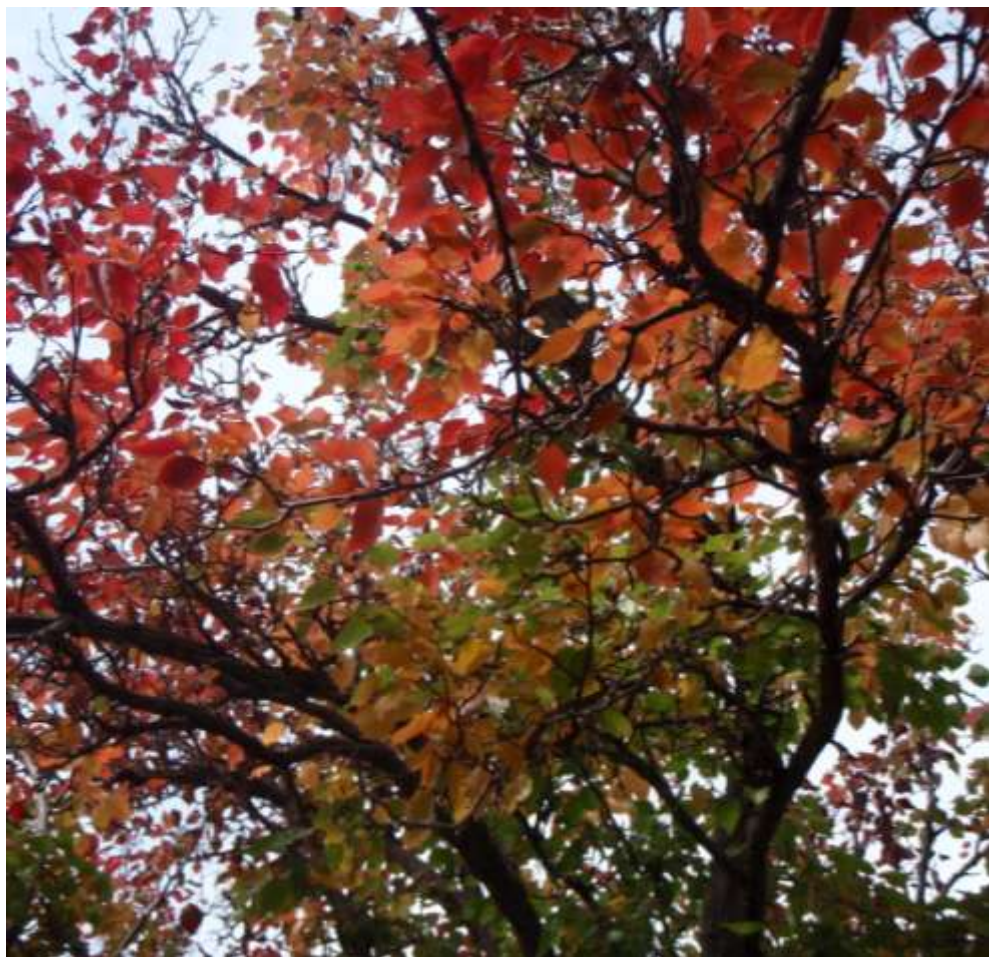

lift up a standard against him.

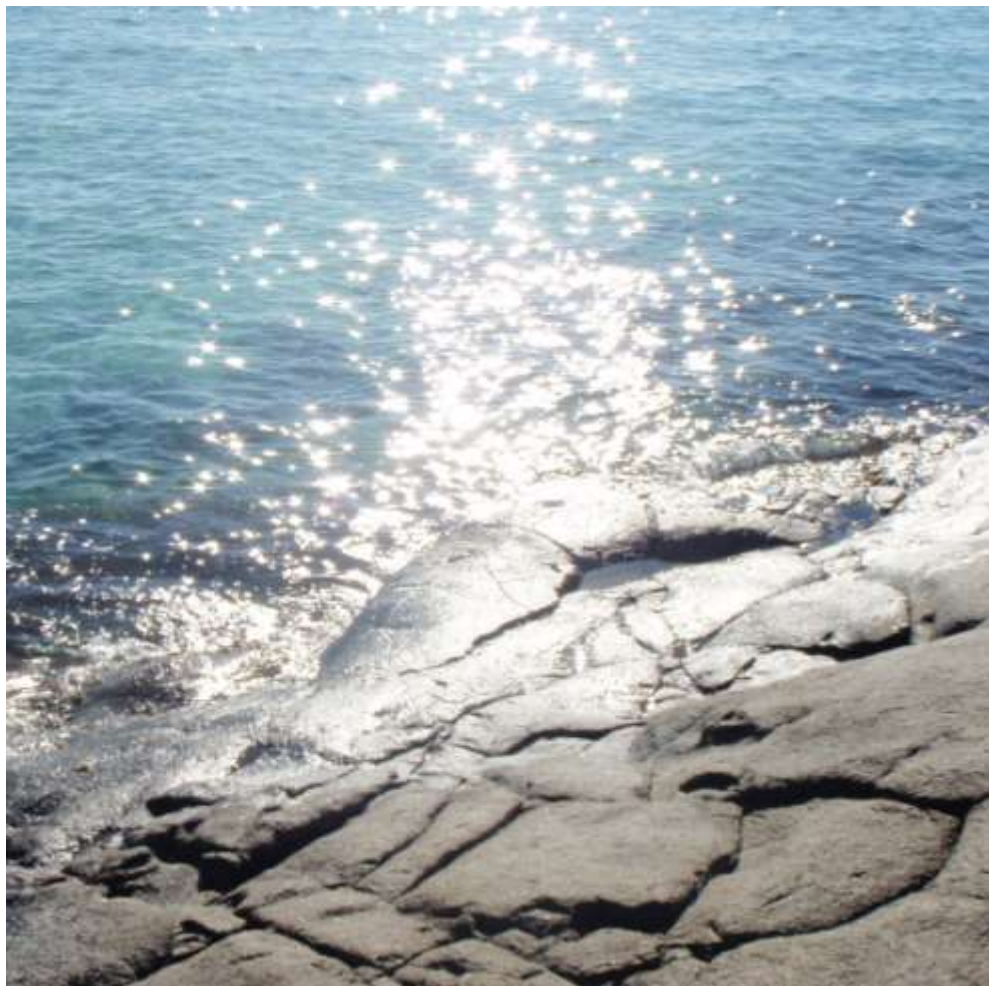
