


# Going God's Way

Sometimes it's hard to know what to do and you wonder what God's way is. Doing things God's way means doing whatever is the most loving thing.

If you're not sure what to do, then ask yourself, "What is the most loving thing to do in this situation?"

#### Truth

If we believe God can do it, and it is something that will bring good in the end, then He is very happy to do anything to help us.


