




FREDDYMEMBER Land is a magical land, where lots of FREDDYMEMBERS live—in fact all of them!

When an animal becomes a FREDDYMEMBER Freddy gives them a special magical kiss, so they can have special magic.




Each FREDDYMEMBER has his or her very own type of magic, which enables them to do certain things.




The more kisses they get the more magic they have.




Every single FREDDYMEMBER loves Freddy, of course.

There is also a road in between FREDDYMEMBER City and FREDDYMEMBER Castle. This road is going across the FREDDYMEMBER Plains.




In FREDDYMEMBER Plains there is Bounty Farm, which the farmer of it is Arfee, a nice dog.
