

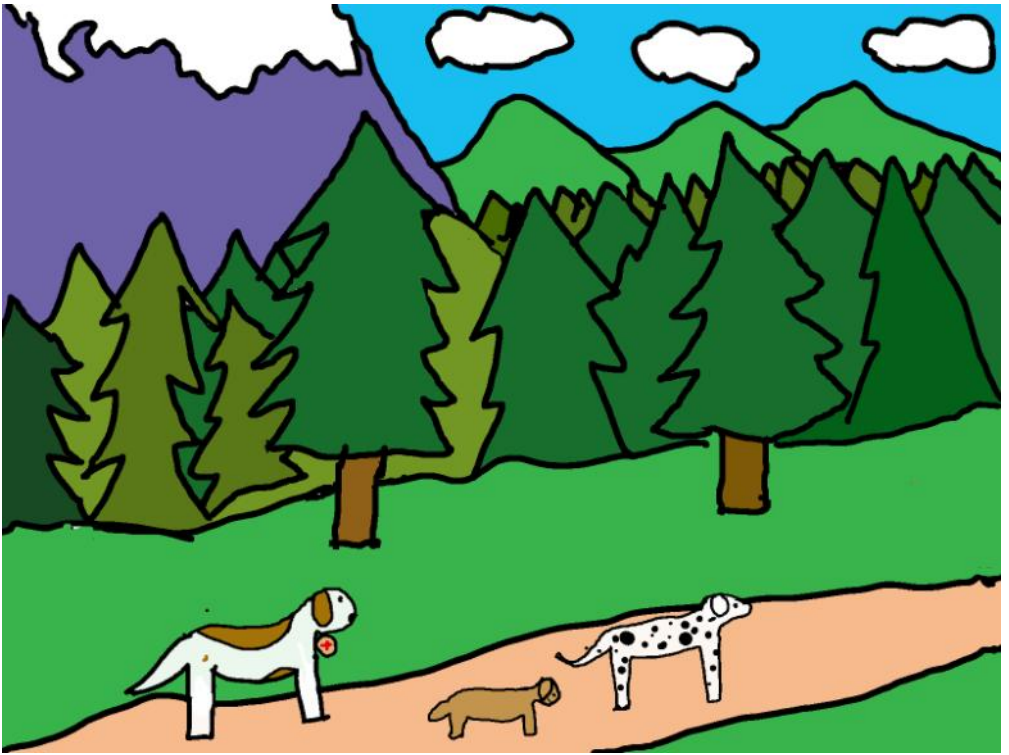

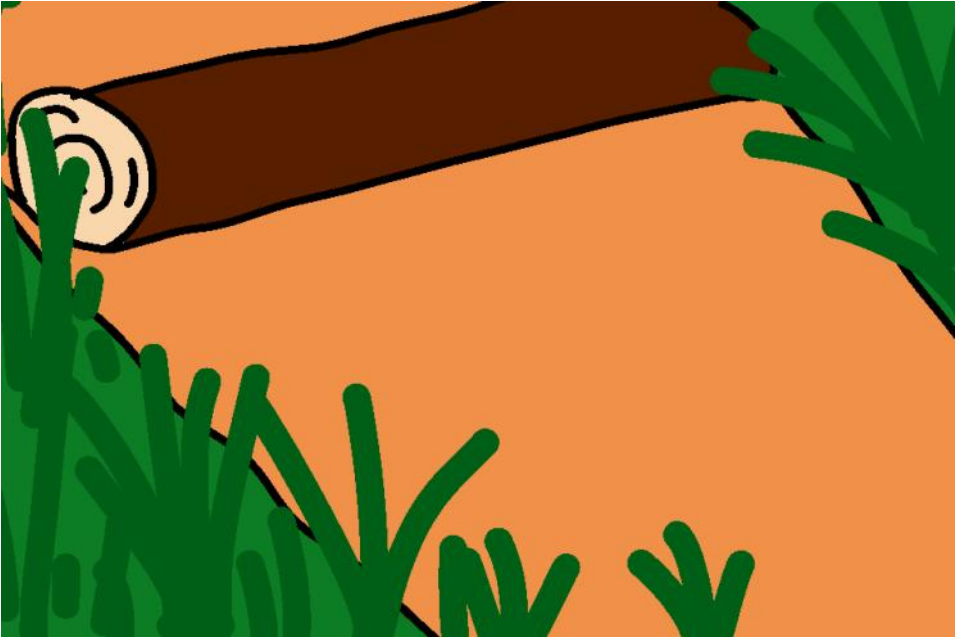
forest Walk

Camping



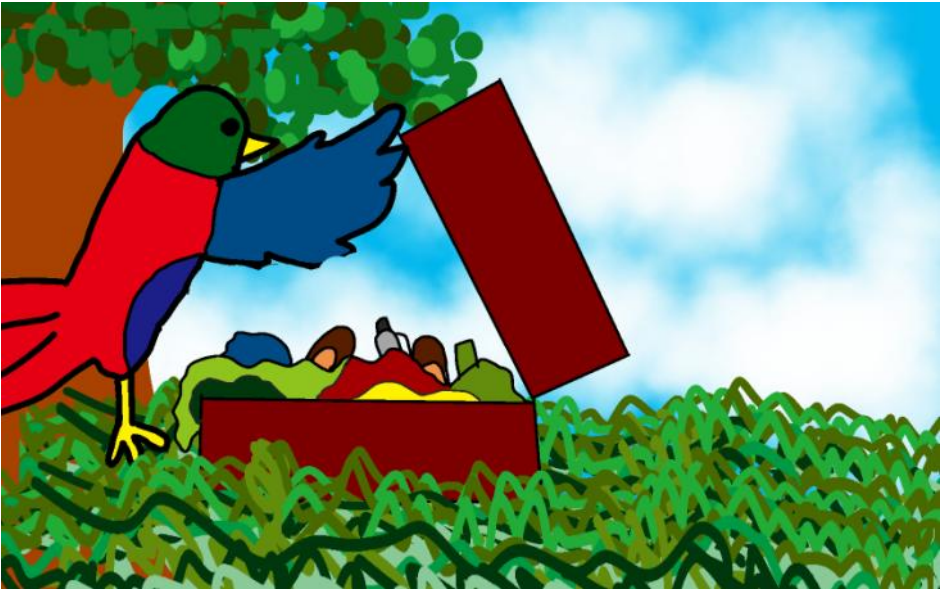

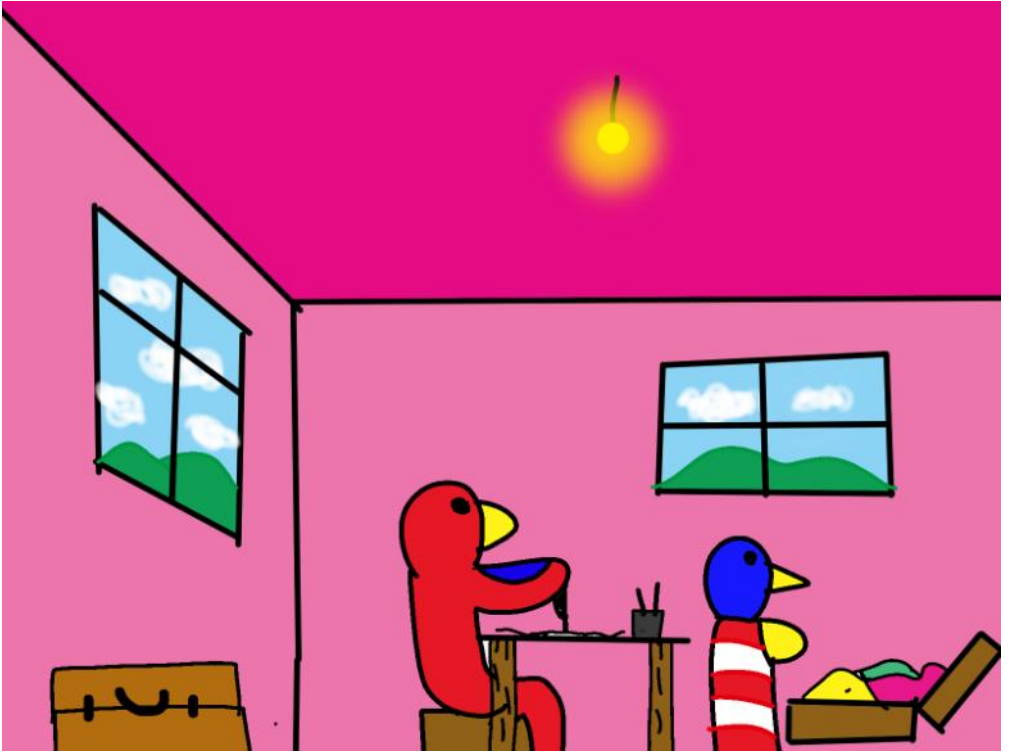

BUT THEY WERE TOO SMALL TO FIT TWO.



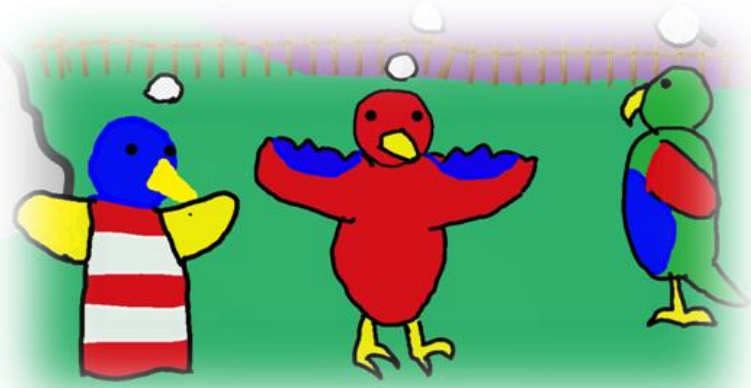
