It's a revolution!! Don't forget it.

I never could go along with things that were clearly against the scriptures. The reason things have to keep being changed and revoluted in sometimes dramatic ways is because people like to settle down too soon, when the job or the mission isn't completed. Then it takes God sending people like me, who are willing to be humiliated, risk their life, and do something to remind people of the truth.

If people were willing to change a little bit every day, change to keep in step with God and the way He is moving, it wouldn't be such a pull and uprooting like if often has to be.

If people can hear from God every day, or at least really read the scriptures with an open mind for God to show them things and ask for His Spirit to teach them what it means for them, then all would keep in step and wouldn't get off track.

But the carnal way of man is to get things all settled and make themselves famous. If people were more concerned about doing the uncomfortable things that brought God more into their's and other's lives—and the things that only glorified the Lord, then things wouldn't have to have these big changes that have caused so much of a stir and conflict and revolution.

But where the spirit of the Lord is there will always be change, for people need it to stay alive and growing in spirit. When they get settled down and think they have learned all they should or want to learn, that's when they get off track, because God has moved on past that lesson.

It's like if a child liked a certain classroom in the big school and then decided for the rest of his life he would only like to attend that room—what would he be missing? There are other grades and so much else outside also to learn.

So when some revival starts out getting people turned to the Lord, but then the followers think that it wasn't just a grade, just something that needed to be learned, but a station to stay at, then they miss learning the next things that God had for them. That's when these movements get off track. Maybe a certain person was used of God and they have led many others to him. But they aren't a mould form for others to copy and stay that way for the next several hundred years. They aren't to be a station for people to stay at—but a train to get people going.

You can learn from the person and the movement, what they brought to the world, if they were God ordained. But then find out fresh from God what you are to do in your part of the world, and how you can promote the truth of God's Word. Don't stay stuck in an idea and place. Move on, live on, teach on, and go on.

So, are you doing today what God wishes for you to do? Are you heeding the scriptures and finding out fresh what they mean for you? They mean something new to each person on Earth depending on the position of their heart and the lessons they are meant to learn. And something in them—a lot of somethings in them—can be right for anyone at any point in world history.

Are you to all build tabernacles just like Moses? Or in stead a temple like Solomon? Or are you to only eat locust and honey like John the Baptist? Or all die for the world on a cross like Jesus? Even if others did have to die that way, they weren't doing it for the salvation of the world. But you can learn from each part of the Bible and let God show you what you are to do for the now.

That's what you can learn over all from the whole story of the Bible from Creation to Revelation—do what God shows you to do; not doing exactly what they did, but doing exactly what God shows you to do, in the way He tells you to do it.

If people could only realise the other main thing that the Bible shows and that is that God still speaks to all—He talked to them then, and expected obedience; He talks to men and woman today and expects obedience, all with the same goal to "preach the Gospel" the truth of God, whatever people living where you are need to hear.

Some areas need more the Endtime message and truth; others need the basic salvation story; others need to learn how to get out and teach others about Jesus; others need to learn how to hear from God and get their faith strengthened.

Even if someone only just heard about Jesus, well there they have a knowledge that others don't have, and they can teach even that little bit of truth that they know. Then when they learn more and study more and listen to God more, then they have more riches and treasures that they can share. Teach others to teach others.

Okay, so you want to know more about how it was like.

One night I remember being home with my family and my many children. There was an eerie air, like something wasn't right. I feared my life or others' was in danger. I couldn't see around the house and didn't want to go looking around anyway. I knew, most likely, that it wasn't just a physical danger, but a paralizing fear that was trying to get my mind off the Lord and what He had for me to do.

I prayed with all my heart against the trouble, whatever it was, and sent it running with the power of God. Then just like that I felt a peace and tranquillity come over me, a light seemed to glow for a moment, and I knew we were being watched over by powers much stronger than any that would try to hinder and bring a stop to our work.



They're born in the white-heat of the fires of inspiration and of the desire for change, and, led by an anointed leader, they fight and die for the Cause until they gain enough followers to "come out from among them and be separate and touch not the unclean thing, and have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness"--and a new "Ecclesia" has been formed-the new "called-out ones", the new church, the new dropouts!

So each time, in order to preserve His Church and his children and the truth and its freedom, God has to call out a new man with some new motive, to make some new move to form a new movement of dropouts from the once new System grown old and corrupt, stagnated, contaminated, and frozen together in formality, inflexible, unbendable, unchangeable old bottles that can only be broken to give birth to the new--just a fragile, empty eggshell which cannot contain the volatile life within.

Like the early "Ecclesia", the "Called Out", the Early Church, we too, have dropped out and started anew--a new life, a new way, but the oldest of all ways--God's Way! "No other foundation can any man lay than this!" We are just getting back to the Foundation--clearing away the old rubble to build anew! As the humourist and playwright George Bernard Shaw said, "There is nothing wrong with Christianity--just so few have ever tried it!" What he meant was he couldn't see many people living it--not even the so called Christians, or the Church!

So first of all, we must build on the right foundation--the man Christ Jesusthe Corner stone! Second, we must build the building He wants! "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; and no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me!"--A building of young and living stones, made alive by His spirit, founded on His Truth, and melted together in His Love! Let's use the best Church he ever created as our pattern! Let's use the Early Church in the Book of Acts as our blueprint! Here was the ideal! --Pastor David

# Inspiring True Stories from History: Timely Supplies

### But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

### (Philippians 4:19)

As sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. (2 Corinthians 6:10)

## (From: "A Retrospect" by James Hudson Taylor, written late 1800s-early 1900's)

November 18th, 1857, James Hudson Taylor penned: "Many seem to think that I am very poor. This certainly is true enough in one sense, but I thank GOD it is "as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, yet possessing all things." (2 Corinthians 6:10) And my GOD shall supply **all** my need; to Him be all the glory. I would not, if I could, be otherwise than I am--entirely dependent myself upon the LORD, and used as a channel of help to others."

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On Saturday, our regular home mail arrived. That morning we supplied, as usual, a breakfast to the destitute poor, who came to the number of seventy. Sometimes they do not reach forty, at others again exceeding eighty. They come to us every day, LORD'S Day excepted, for then we cannot manage to attend to them and get through all our other duties too. Well, on that Saturday morning we paid all expenses, and provided ourselves for the morrow, after which we had not a single dollar left between us.

How the LORD was going to provide for Monday we knew not; but over our mantelpiece hung two scrolls in the Chinese character--Ebenezer, "Hitherto hath the LORD helped us" (1 Samuel 7:12); and Jehovah-Jireh, "The LORD will provide" (Genesis 22:8,14)--and He kept us from doubting for a moment.

That very day the mail came in, a week sooner than was expected, and Mr. Jones received a bill for two hundred and fourteen dollars. We thanked GOD and took courage. The bill was taken to a merchant, and although there is usually a delay of several days in getting the change, this time he said, "Send down on Monday." We sent, and though he had not been able to buy all the dollars, he let us have seventy on account; so all was well. Oh, it is sweet to live thus directly dependent upon the LORD, who never fails us!

On Monday the poor had their breakfast as usual, for we had not told them not to come, being assured that it was the LORD'S work, and that the LORD would provide. We could not help our eyes filling with tears of gratitude when we saw not only our own needs supplied, but the widow and the orphan, the blind and the lame, the friendless and the destitute, together provided for by the bounty of Him who feeds the ravens. "O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt His Name together.... Taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that

trusteth in Him. O fear the LORD, ye His saints: for there is no want to them that fear Him. The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing"--and if not good, why want it?

But even two hundred dollars cannot last for ever, and by New Year's Day supplies were again getting low. At last, on January 6th, 1858, only one solitary cash remained--the twentieth part of a penny--in the joint possession of Mr. Jones and myself; but though tried we looked to GOD once again to manifest His gracious care. Enough provision was found in the house to supply a meagre breakfast; after which, having neither food for the rest of the day, nor money to buy any, we could only betake ourselves to Him who was able to supply all our need with the petition, "Give us this day our daily bread."

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After prayer and deliberation we thought that perhaps we ought to dispose of something we possessed in order to meet our immediate requirements. But on looking round we saw nothing that we could well spare, and little that the Chinese would purchase for ready money. Credit\* to any extent we might have had, could we conscientiously have availed ourselves of it, but this we felt to be unscriptural in itself, as well as inconsistent with the position we were in. (\*Borrowing money—Romans 13:8)

We had, indeed, one article--an iron stove--which we knew the Chinese would readily purchase; but we much regretted the necessity of parting with it. At length, however, we set out to the founder's, and after a walk of some distance came to the river, which we had intended to cross by a floating bridge of boats; but here the LORD shut up our path. The bridge had been carried away during the preceding night, and the river was only passable by means of a ferry, the fare for which was two cash each person. As we only possessed one cash, our course clearly was to return and await GOD'S own interposition on our behalf.


Upon reaching home, we found that Mrs. Jones had gone with the children to dine at a friend's house, in accordance with an invitation accepted some days previously. Mr. Jones, though himself included in the invitation, refused now to go and leave me to fast alone. So we set to work and carefully searched the cupboards; and though there was nothing to eat, we found a small packet of cocoa, which, with a little hot water, somewhat revived us. After this we again cried to the LORD in our trouble, and the LORD heard and saved us out of all our distresses. For while we were still upon our knees a letter arrived from England containing a remittance\*. (\*Sending of money by mail.)

This timely supply not only met the immediate and urgent need of the day; for in the assured confidence that GOD, whose we were and whom we served, would not put to shame those whose whole and only trust was in Himself. My marriage had been previously arranged to take place just fourteen days after this date. And this expectation was not disappointed; for "the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of My peace be removed." And although during subsequent years our faith was often exercised, and sometimes severely, He ever proved faithful to His promise, and never suffered us to lack any good thing.
