Tips for Fun and Easy Memorising:

- ◆ Read it out loud to the children
- ◆ Let them see it
- ◆ Let them hear it, repeatedly
- ◆ Teach one bit at a time, and have them repeat each bit back to you
- ◆ Sing it and/or clap to its rhythm
- ◆ Let them say it aloud to you
- ◆ Reward them when a verse or booklet has been memorised
