I got so mad, the longer I watched and the more I saw, and I thought of that candy. I wouldn't touch a piece of that kind of rock crystal sugar candy! Giving these little kids bags of poison rots your teeth! I was a young teenager. I was trying to teach the young people to be spiritual and love the Lord. And here they were having all this stuff that had nothing to do with Jesus, on His Birthday!

So right at the height of all this foolishness I burst out with, "Happy Birthday to You! Happy Birthday to You!" And they started looking at me like I'd lost my mind!-- Like I was crazy!--What was I doing singing "Happy Birthday" when this was Christmas!

Maybe if he's disturbed he makes that noise, and you'd think a robber or a thief would be a little bit worried about causing any disturbance or any sound. I was leaving the next morning after I'd shown the slides that night, but the trailer park man had allowed me to show my slides only on one condition: "You can't take an offering."

He didn't want me to do it for money, like I was making money off of his customers.

So we were really flat broke the next morning. We had a dollar-and-a-half or something like that and I said,

"Well, it's enough to buy a tank of gas and at least we can get to the next town."

And just as we were packing up and hitching up our trailer and leaving, the newsboy walked up with his hand clasped, he had a bill palmed in his hand, and he put this folded bill into my hand.

I shook his hand heartily and thanked him, and of course it wasn't exactly polite to pull it out and look and see how much it was, so I just stuck it in my pocket.

I'll tell you what I had faith for, about \$5, and that was quite a bit in those days. I'll never forget, when he put it in my hand he said,

"Here, Preacher! You know, it was a good thing you did last night, and these little kids here, they really needed it! They're a bunch of wild Indians and they never go to church and they've never heard anything like that before, so that was really good for them! I'm so glad you did that, that was really good!"

And he shook my hand and put the bill in my hand!

So when I got out on the highway I said, "Well, we' better stop and get some groceries now we've got some money!"

So Mother [and the children] stayed in the car and my wife and I got out and started walking across the street.

There's a huge big six-lane highway. And I got across the first three lanes, about in the middle, when I pulled out the bill to see what it was, and I jumped straight up in the air and shouted "Hallelujah!"—right out in the middle of all that traffic!

It was a fifty-dollar bill! That was one of the biggest gifts we ever got!—And from a newsboy! It's the poor who support God's Work!.

We went a long ways on that \$50 in those days! It really thrilled me, and boy, I really went great with my [Bible] slides and showings and meetings from then on!
