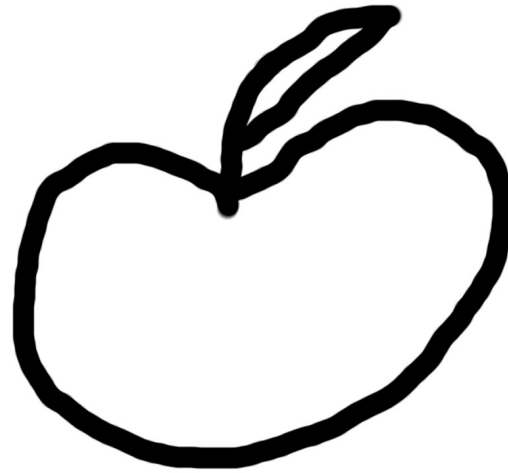
1.) Thousands of years ago it was very black in

Fruit trees and edibles grew from the ground.



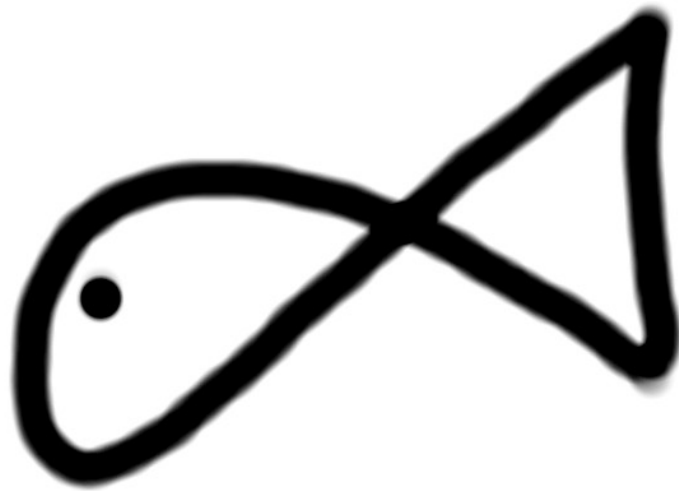
4.) Figs, plums, peaches, mangoes, dates and cherries;

“Multiply”, God said, and so new life would grow.



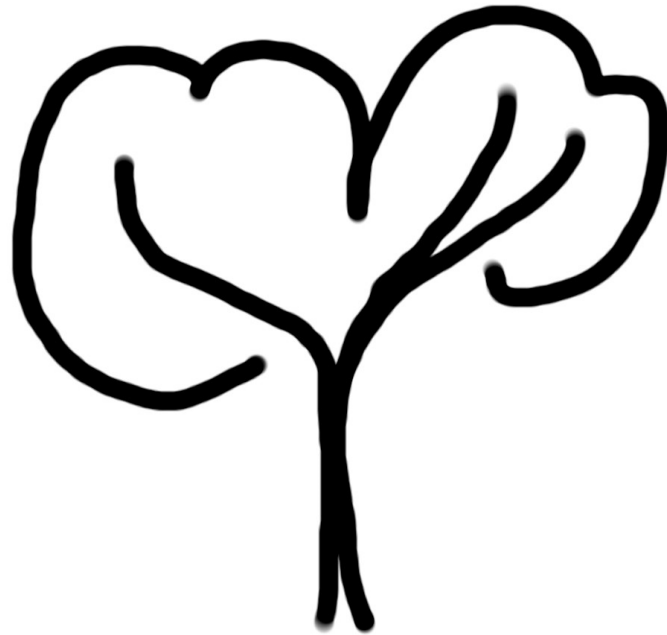
8.) On day six, Creation's final day,

They crawled, hopped, dug, slithered and galloped.



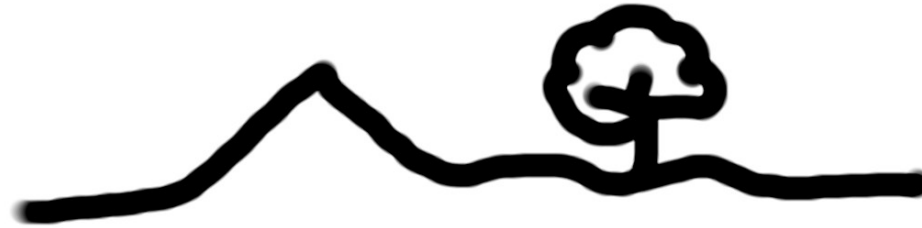
9.) God made bunny rabbits, lizards and wombats;

Pain, sorrow, and trouble, because of sin.



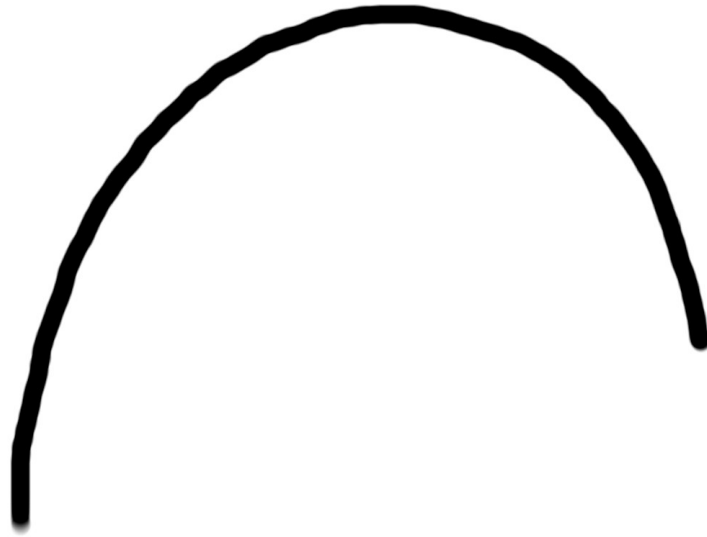
13.) God loved each person He had made,

The one who made 'em! -For a good man God sought.



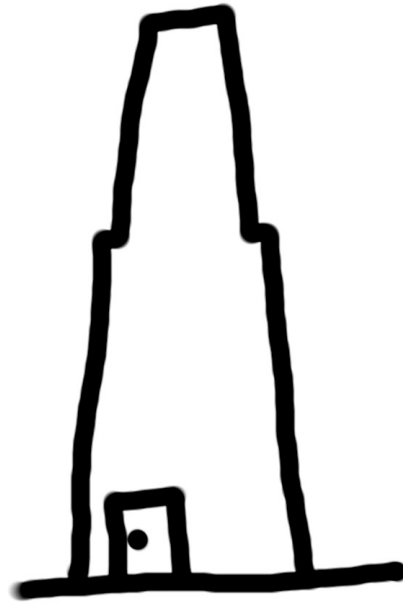
14.) Noah was found to be good in heart,

To build an ark, and with animals they entered in.



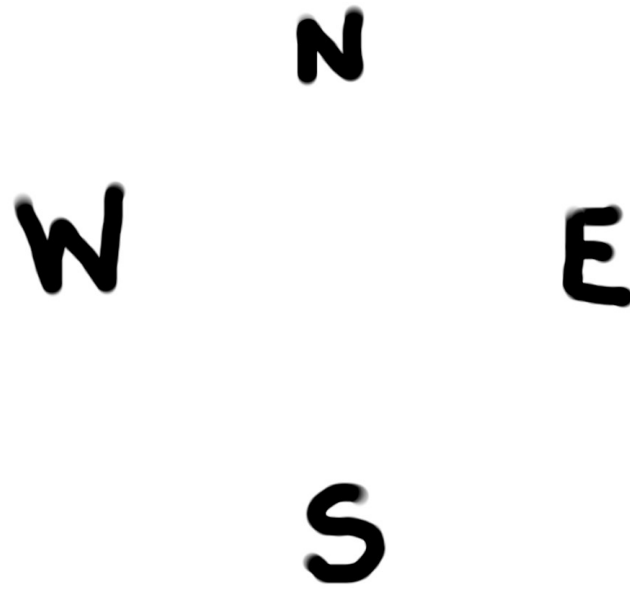
15.) The promised flood came at last,
