



A Travelling Day




3.) God said he'd have a son one day,

4.) When water and grass was in short supply A solution needed, Abraham was the guy To suggest Lot choose a better place to go; Patience and unselfishness he did show.






6.) Isaac at last was born and learned as he grew, How to talk with God, and have faith too.


