

The only way out to escape the troubles that are coming to those who still choose the evil is to become a part of God's family.



"I know I've been bad and selfish. I am just human. There is no way I can live forever, and be good enough on my own for You to have me live with You forever in Heaven.








"I want to be washed of all the wrong and evil that has messed up my heart and mind, and I want to start again, as a new child in my new family—the Family of God.
