Thank You, Jesus! You're the best!



I know You are right with me, even when I'm playing. You love to be with me. I want to please You in all that I do, as my way of saying, "Thank You" for giving to me all that I have.




Nose


Eyes

Mouth


Dear Jesus,

Christmas


Dear Jesus,

Easter


Dear Jesus,

Show me what goals to reach for, and give me determination to make progress in each area of my life.




I want to live a healthy and good life, and I want to have good habits of happy living in this new year.
